NOMINATION FORM FOR GENERAL ELECTION 2020-2022

The General Election 2020–2022 of the Good Hope School Parent Teacher Association (PTA) is going to take place on 21st November 2020 (Sat). There are eight vacancies for this election. If the number of candidates exceeds the number of vacancies, the first eight candidates with the highest number of votes shall become the Executive Committee Members; whereas if the number of candidates does not exceed the number of positions to be filled by the election, a general election will not be held and each candidate shall take office for a full term.

Elected candidates, together with Teacher Executive Committee Members and Ex-officio Advisors, should decide among themselves the duties to be assigned. For a detailed description of the respective positions, please refer to Section 9 of the “Articles of Association” under “Communication / Constitution” on <http://ghs-pta.org>.

You may nominate a maximum of 3 parents to run for the posts in the Executive Committee. The name(s) of the candidate(s) must be the same as that on their HKID card(s). The candidate(s) must sign on the nomination form as acknowledgement. Each candidate needs to fill in one nomination form only. Please use ONE nomination form for ONE candidate. Photocopies of nomination forms are acceptable.

All candidates will be invited for an interview on 7th October (Wed). Ballots will be delivered no later than 21st October (Wed) and the Annual General Meeting is scheduled on 21st November (Sat). If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact our Election committee member Elec Ho.
