週年會務報告

本人非常榮幸代表本屆執行委員會各委員，向各位匯報過去一年的會務。感謝學校及委員們的信任和支持，讓本人可以與各位攜手並進，為學校及家長奉獻微薄心力。

首先，有請司庫鄭基禮先生報告本會在二零二三至二零二四年的財務狀況：

一、財務事宜

截至二零二四年八月三十一日，本會儲備基金結存為港幣一百一十二萬一千四百零九元整(HKD1,121,409)，去年同期則為港幣一百一十二萬七千七百一十四元整(HKD1,127,714)。詳情請參閱後附的財務報告。

去年，本會獲教育局「家庭與學校合作事宜委員會」撥款港幣四萬五千九百七十八元整(HKD45,978)，作為本會一般營運及活動經費。

由於「執委會」訂定了嚴格的營運經費使用守則，本會營運基金結存能恆常處於充裕水平。本會將善用家教會資金，繼續為會員及學校籌辦更多有意義的活動。

二零二三至二零二四年度，本會籌辦了多項不同類型的活動及服務，當中包括：

(一) 推動及支持學生活動

(甲) 校園微型小說比賽

家長教師會今年以「未來」為主題，舉辦「校園微型小說比賽」。面對充滿挑戰、變幻莫測的未來，同學們勇於思考、期望改變，用細膩的筆觸寫下對未來的期盼和憧憬。

(乙) 畢業襟針設計比賽

從二零一四年開始舉辦的畢業襟針設計比賽，本會每年均邀請全校同學參與，發掘每一位同學與眾不同的設計天賦。勝出的設計作品將製作成應屆畢業襟針，送給中六畢業生留念。

今年勝出的畢業襟針設計者梁倩滂同學，藉著作品，祝福畢業生勇敢擁抱變化，無所畏懼，踏上成長之旅，在人生路上大放異彩。

今年設計的款式深受歡迎，本會特別增加了襟針訂製數量送贈家長義工，以答謝她們的無私奉獻。本會也開放予其他年級的同學訂購留念。

(丙) 借用畢業袍服務

學校訂購了全新的畢業袍，讓畢業生們可以選擇租借或購買，將中學生涯美好的校園記憶帶回家。本會祝願同學們未來鵬程萬里，前程似錦！

(丁) 季節性流感疫苗注射計劃

為保障師生健康，家長教師會每年均聯繫「基督教聯合那打素社康服務」的外展服務，在流感高峰期前，為師生安排流感疫苗注射服務。

在校方及家長義工的協助下，二零二四年共有七百二十二名師生參加了季節性流感疫苗注射計劃。

(戊) 小五茶聚

今年中學部再度與德望小學暨幼稚園(小學部)攜手，為即將準備升讀中學的小學五年級同學舉辦「小五茶聚」。

本年度的聚會邀請了中學部的師姐和家長一起出席，透過分享了解中學校園的生活花絮和升中後的讀書心得，全場四百多名師生及家長聚首一堂，和樂融融，場面溫馨滿溢。

(己) 運動校隊年度聚會暨頒獎典禮

今年運動校隊年度聚會熱鬧非凡，競技項目包括羽毛球、乒乓球、網球、劍擊、室內划艇、曲棍球、籃球、足球、沙灘排球、手球、籃球、網球以及田徑、越野跑、游泳、彈網、射箭、拯溺、足毬等個人項目均取得卓越佳績。

中小學部體育組與家長教師會攜手，邀請獲獎校隊、優秀運動員和近千名與會者分享她們在運動場上揮灑汗水和淚水的故事，一起見證榮耀歡欣的時刻。

(二) 會訊

會訊是其中一項與會員溝通的重要渠道，本會每年均出版兩次《家長教師會會訊》。內容涵蓋「中學文憑試」成績優異同學的分享以及家長教師會舉辦的各項活動等，讓會員了解家長教師會的運作及活動資訊。

今年非常榮幸邀請優秀家長義工投稿，為學校與老師送上濃濃的謝意，也為會訊增添姿采。

(三) 獎學金

本會每年均頒發獎學金予中學文憑試考獲優異成績的同學，以及「畢業襟針設計比賽」的優秀設計者。

今年同樣增設獎學金予「校園微型小說比賽」勝出的老師、家長和同學，以資鼓勵。

(四) 家校合作

(甲) 集體代購家政用品

本會每年都會為中一學生集體代購家政科用品，減輕家長四處奔波購買各種物資的壓力，此項服務深受家長和同學支持。今年本會共為家長代購三百套家政科用品。

(乙) 非遺DIY掐絲景泰藍杯墊手工工作坊

本會深信，凝聚家校合作力量，建立愉快的學習環境，對學生的成長極為重要。因此特別增設不同渠道加強家校溝通。今年舉辦的非遺DIY掐絲景泰藍杯墊手工工作坊，邀請家長和學生一起參與，藉手工製作景泰藍杯墊，了解景泰藍的歷史、製作工藝及技巧，分享景泰藍工藝在中國文化中的重要地位，以及其在藝術界的價值和應用。

每位參加者在製作過程中，不僅可以了解景泰藍工藝獨特的魅力，也加深了家長之間的認識和交流，建構和諧家校關愛文化。

(丙) 家長諮詢服務台

學校非常重視家校溝通，在家長日特別設立家長教師會「家長信息分享」服務台，通過蒐集家長意見、解答家長疑問、傳遞家校訊息，增進家長對學校的了解，攜手成為孩子成功路上的最佳搭檔。

在中一新生家長日，本會也為新加入德望大家庭的家長及家長義工舉辦迎新講座，幫助家長了解孩子的校園生活，掌握更多學校及家長教師會的活動資訊。

在學校資訊日和面試日，本會也邀請家長義工，接待來年的準中一學生和家長，讓每位訪客均能感受德望大家庭的熱情和溫暖。

(五) 其他活動

(甲) 電影欣賞會

暑期電影觀賞會已成為親子聚會的好時光。今年暑假，本會邀請校長、副校長、家長及學生一起欣賞動畫成長電影《Inside Out 2》。這部電影探討青少年在青春期情緒的變化，讓我們反思每種情緒均有其作用，毋需抑壓或者逃避負面情緒。本會希望通過影片，與家長和學生一起分享如何理解情緒背後的訊息，嘗試擁抱不同的情緒，接納完整自我。

(乙) 與家長教師會聚會

二零二三年聖誕節，家長教師會在這喜迎新年的日子裏，與家長歡聚一堂，邀請校長Dr. Gary Harfitt分享學校最新資訊，亦邀請了生涯規劃主任曾世光老師，與家長分享如何指引孩子根據自己的興趣與能力，規劃未來。

(丙) 家長教師會感謝午宴

在學校的支持下，今年家長教師會感謝午宴邀請教職員、工友、以及家長義工歡聚一堂。家長教師會希望藉此機會感謝各位的大力支持與協助，讓家校合作的力量聚沙成塔。

ANNUAL REPORT

It is my great honor, on behalf of the Good Hope School (GHS) Parent-Teacher Association ('PTA', 'Association') Executive Committee members, to submit the annual report for the Annual General Meeting (AGM) for 2023-2024.

Thank you to all the committee members this year for their dedication and hard work. As American inspirational author Robert Collier once said, "Success is the sum of small efforts, repeated day in and day out." Thank you to the school for providing an excellent environment and learning atmosphere, to every outstanding teacher for your companionship and guidance, and to each wonderful parent volunteer for their selfless dedication to the school, we appreciate having a team full of fervor and people who will do their best to build a bridge between home and school to promote the development of the PTAs aims.

On behalf of the PTA, I would like to take this opportunity to thank our Supervisor Sr. Pauline, Principal Dr. Harfitt, Vice-principal Mr. Paul Chow, Vice-principal Ms. Helen Yu, Vice-principal Mr. Leander Pang, teachers, and supporting staff for their behind-the-scenes support of the PTA.

We appreciate the school's full support of the Parent-Teacher Association, as well as the unity between the Parent-Teacher Association and all teachers and students. With this, we can face the future with complete confidence, let us move forward with gratitude and humility!

First, Mr. Kenny Cheng, the Treasurer, will present the financial information.

1. Finance

The Association had a reserve fund of HK\$1,121,409 as of 31 August 2024, compared to HK\$1,127,714 during the same period last year.

Over the past year, a subsidy of HK\$45,855 was granted by the Committee on Home-School Co-operation (HSC) of the Education Bureau for the operation of the Association and for the organization of activities.

Due to the strict rules on the use of the operating fund, and the well-defined operating procedures stipulated by the Executive Committee, the operating fund has always been at a sound and stable level. In the future, the Association would like to spend its funds on organizing meaningful activities for its members and the School.

2. Internal Affairs

The Parent-Teacher Association (PTA) has organized and arranged a variety of activities over the year. I am so proud and blessed to have worked with an amazing group of parents and teachers in the executive committee this year. The work of the PTA would not have been so successful without the support and participation of the parent volunteers and the PTA members of Good Hope School.

Events undertaken this year have included:

I. Events/Activities

(A) Writing Competition 2024

This year, the Parent-Teacher Association held the "Writing Competition" with the theme of "Future". Facing a challenging and unpredictable future, the students dare to think, hope for change, and write down their expectations and longings for the future with delicate writing.

(B) Graduation Pin Design Competition

Since 2014, the Association has organized a Graduation Pin Design Competition every inviting all students to participate in creating their unique designs. The winning design is made into Graduation Pins, which are given to each Secondary 6 graduate as a souvenir.

The winner of this year's graduation pin designer Trudy Leung shared her hopes that each serves as a blessing for graduates to fearlessly embrace changes as they embark upon the journey of growth, and shine brightly in their future endeavor.

The styles designed this year are very popular. The association has specially increased the number of customized pins as souvenirs to parent volunteers to thank them for their selfless dedication. The association also welcomes other students to place orders.

(C) Graduation Gown

This year, the school has ordered brand new graduation robes, allowing graduates to choose to rent or buy them and take home the memories of their wonderful secondary school days. The Association wishes the students a bright and prosperous future.

(D) Influenza Vaccination Program

To protect teachers' and students' health, the Parent Teacher Association (PTA) contacted the Outreach Service of the United Christian Nethersole Community Health Service (UCNCHS) to provide our students with tetravalent flu vaccination. With support from the school and parent volunteers, there were 722 injections administered during this program.

(E) P5 Tea Gathering

This year, the Secondary Section joined hands with the Primary section to organize a "P.5 Tea Gathering" for Primary 5 students who are about to enter secondary school.

This gathering was hosted by the senior school sisters from the secondary section, who shared their experiences in entering higher education and studying for the P5 students from

the primary section. Nearly 400 teachers, students, and parents in the audience shared titbits' of campus life; the atmosphere over the gathering was warm and friendly.

(F) Annual Sports Team Gathering 2024

The Annual Gathering of the School Sports Team is very lively this year, given the outstanding results they have achieved in competitive events such as Badminton, Table Tennis, Tennis, Fencing, Indoor rowing, Hockey, Basketball, Football, Beach Volleyball, Handball, Netball, as well as individual events such as Athletics, Cross-Country, Swimming, Trampoline, Archery, Life Saving and Shuttlecock.

The secondary section and primary section sports teams joined hands with the Parent-Teacher Association to invite the award-winning school teams, and outstanding athletes to share their stories of sweat and tears with nearly a thousand attendees witnessing the glorious and joyous moment together.

II. Newsletter

The newsletter is one of the most important channels through which the PTA communicates with its members. The Association publishes the "Parent-Teacher Association Newsletter" twice a year, covering the learning experiences of students with outstanding results in the "DSE", various activities organized by the PTA, etc. The primary aim is to inform parents about the information, and operation of the PTA.

This year, we are much honored to invite outstanding parent volunteers to contribute articles. They thanked teachers for their careful teaching and care, and sent their deep respect and gratitude to the them, adding a motivational message to the volunteer's team.

III. Scholarships

Following the traditional practice, the Association awarded scholarships to the top students who obtained the highest overall results in the DSE. The Association also presented awards to the top three teachers, parents, and students in the Writing Competition.

IV. Home-School Cooperation

A. T&L Tools Purchase

Every year, the Association collectively purchases T&L tools for Secondary 1 students to relieve the pressure on parents, and this practice is well-supported by parents and students. The Association helped to provide 300 sets of T&L tools for new students.

B. Intangible Cultural Heritage Handicraft DIY Cloisonné Coasters workshop

The Association believes that a good home-school partnership is crucial to the growth of students. Therefore, the Association has set up different channels to strengthen home-school communication. The DIY Cloisonné Coasters workshop was held this year for parents and students to create the Intangible Cultural Heritage Handicraft, Cloisonné coasters. They learnt about the history, production techniques, and the important position of Cloisonné craftsmanship in Chinese culture, as well as its value and application in the art world.

During the production process, each participant not only understood the unique charm of cloisonné craftsmanship but also deepened the understanding and communication between parents and built a harmonious home-school caring culture.

C. Parents Information Sharing Service Counter and Parents Orientation day

The Association set up a "Parents Information Sharing" Service Counter specifically on Parents' Day and Orientation Day.

We hoped that by collecting parents' opinions and communicating home and school information, parents' understanding of the school will be enhanced. On the New S.1 Parents' Day, we also held a seminar for the parent volunteers who have just joined the GHS family to help new parents understand their children's school life and the activities of the PTA.

During the school information day and interview day, the association also invited parent volunteers to welcome coming S.1 students and their parents, so that every visitor could feel the enthusiasm and warmth of the Good Hope family.

V. Other activities (Film Appreciation and Donate Event)

A. Film Appreciation

Film Appreciation during the summer holiday has become a good time for parents and children to get together. This summer, the Association has chosen the animated coming-of-age film "Inside Out 2" and invited the principal, vice principal, parents, and students to watch it together.

This film explores the emotional changes of teenagers during adolescence, the message of the movie is unique and powerful: we do not need to suppress our emotions, we need sadness to be emotionally healthy.

The PTA would like to share with parents and students ways to understand and embrace every emotion, and accept the complete self.

B. Meeting with the PTA

On Christmas Day 2023, the Parent-Teacher Association invited parents to gather together to welcome the new year. Principal Dr. Harfitt shared the latest information about the school, and the Head of Careers Guidance & Other Learning Experiences Committee Mr. Eddy Tsang, was specially invited to share with parents how to guide their children to analyze, understand, and make career plans based on their interests and abilities.

C. Thank You Lunch

With the support of the school, this year's "Thank You Lunch" brought together School, staff, and parent volunteers.

The Association hopes to thank all parties for their strong support and assistance in strengthening the power of home-school cooperation.

VI. Volunteer Parents

The association actively responds to and assists in various activities organized by the school, such as work internship program for Form 5 students, and orientation day.

This year, the team of parent volunteers of the Parent-Teacher Association is growing day by day. We are fortunate to have met a group of energetic and enthusiastic parent volunteers and committee members who are working hard to create a good example of successful home-school cooperation. Thank you to all the Parent-Teacher Association members and parent volunteers for your selfless dedication.
